

## Honors in Biochemistry/Molecular Biology

Students can receive BMB Honors with additional course work. Additional requirements include:

1. participation in the University Honors Program
2. cumulative gpa of 3.30, as well as a 3.50 gpa in BMB
3. the courses: MAT 147, PHY 110 and 111, BSC/CHE 299\*\*

\*\* Students intending to pursue Departmental Honors in BMB should contact the BMB Program Coordinator prior to enrolling in CHE 230. To receive BMB Honors, two semester hours credit in BSC/CHE 299 must be completed and result in a research paper written in a style acceptable for thesis research. The research paper must be defended in a program seminar.

Please note that 3 hours of 299 are required in order to earn other Honors Program designations, and that students must earn 3 hours of Honors credit each semester. Students are encouraged to meet with an Honors advisor to learn about other designation opportunities.
