

## **DEPARTMENTAL HONORS IN SOCIAL WORK**

The School of Social Work offers qualified students the challenge and distinction of earning Honors through independent study and approved course work. Students completing requirements will receive an Honors Degree in Social Work which will be indicated on the student's official transcript and diploma.

### **Admission Requirements**

In order to be admitted to the Honors Program in Social Work, the candidate must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a declared major in Social Work
2. Be in the University Honors Program
3. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.3 and at least 3.5 in the Social Work major.
4. Should have completed at least 60 semester hours of credit of college and university level courses
5. Should have completed at least 9 semester hours of coursework required for the major (i.e. SWK 170, SOA 131, PSY 350).

Application should be made to the student's advisor in Social Work and the Honors Program.

### **Social Work Departmental Honors Requirements**

In order to graduate as an Honors Graduate in Social Work, the student must meet all university graduation requirements and requirements for the Social Work major.

Additional requirements are:

1. Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.3
2. Must have earned a 3.5 GPA in major
3. Must complete at least 12 hours of Honors work in Social Work (or major required courses, excluding SWK 394, SWK 395, SWK 398.10 and SWK 398.11).
